



Expired White Firearm Licence(s):

As per SAPS directive on the 6th of July 2022; all individuals who are in possession of an expired 'white' firearm licence card(s) has been granted an opportunity in order to reapply for their expired firearm licence(s). Ranyati Firearm Motivations can assist clients with the administration and motivation required for their expired 'white' firearm licence card(s). Please see below information outlining our Expired Firearm Licence Service we are offering:

Expired Firearm Licence Service Explained:

- Competency Renewal:** Please note that if your firearm licence has expired, your SAPS Competency Certificate may also require renewal, as competency is often linked to the validity period of your first obtained 10-year firearm licence. The SAPS generally requires a valid competency certificate prior to submission of an expired firearm licence application. Where required, we can assist by preparing the competency renewal and motivation simultaneously.
- What do we require:** Please complete the questionnaire below as far as possible and return it to us via email together with the requested supporting documents.
- Once completed:** Upon completion of your motivation, you will be notified via email. The packet will consist of a detailed motivation as well as the supporting documents to accompany your Expired Firearm Licence Application for submission at your nearest SAPS.
- Submission:** Upon completing your documentation, you then submit to your Designated Firearm Officer (DFO) situated at your nearest SAPS in the area where you ordinarily reside. No one can submit the application(s) on your behalf to the SAPS.
- Please Note:** The SAPS Directive of 6th of July 2022 is only applicable to individuals who wish to apply for their own expired white firearm licence card(s) or for an expired white firearm licence card(s) from a deceased estate. Unfortunately, the directive does not make provision that you can apply for someone else's expired white firearm licence card(s).

Expired Firearm Licence Service Fees: *Please tick below which services you would like to make use of:*

- Expired Firearm Licence Motivation – R920:** Our fees are R920 per motivation, per firearm. We prepare a detailed motivation on your behalf.

- SAPS517(g) Competency Renewal Application form – R405:** Our fees are R405. We complete the Application form on your behalf. *Please assist with a copy of your SAPS Competency Certificate (front and back if white card type).*
- Courier Services:** Within Gauteng – R220.00 & Outside Gauteng – R250.00. *Please note, we do not email motivations.*
